Dear Camp Snowball Campers, Parents & Guardians,

Camp Warwick is pleased to announce the Camp Snowball dates for Fall and Winter 2016/17. We are looking forward to two weekends of fun-filled activities including recreation, singing, games, religious education, small group discussion, dancing, and bowling.

Enclosed is a registration packet for the Camp Snowball program. Since registration is limited, please return your completed registration forms with full payment as soon as possible. These programs tend to fill up quickly. Camp Snowball is open to all campers ages 8 – 55 who have mild to moderate disabilities and are toilet-trained. We have limited access for those in wheelchairs. Also, due to our limited registration, we can accommodate only four participants from the same group home in any given session.

We are required by New York State to have specific information on record for all campers regarding the use of over-the-counter medications as well as prescription medications. Please be sure that you have your doctor complete both the AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICATIONS form as well as the AUTHORIZATION FOR ADMINISTERING PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES. You may mail this form with your registration or bring it with you when you come to camp. **IF WE ARE NOT IN RECEIPT OF THESE FORMS AT CAMP REGISTRATION, WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ACCOMMODATE YOUR CAMPER. NO REFUNDS WILL BE AWARDED IN THIS SITUATION.**

Please note that we will also need to have your immunization record from the camper's doctor on file for Camp Snowball. Be sure that your immunization record is accurate. Camp Warwick at the Warwick Conference Center requires that **ALL CAMPERS (AGES 8 – 55) have the HEPATITIS B immunization series\* and a current TB test (PPD or Mantoux)** unless medically contraindicated or for religious purposes – refer to enclosed Health Form.

\* You need not have completed the Hep B series, but you must have started the immunization series.

We are looking forward to seeing all of our returning Camp Sunrise/Snowball campers this season, as well as looking forward to welcoming those of you who are new to this program. If you are new to the Camp Snowball program, we would like to share some general information about the program with you.

- The Camp Snowball program will take place at the Warwick Conference Center facilities, **NOT** at Camp Warwick's camp buildings. (Continue up the paved road past Mulder Chapel to Schoonmaker Lodge, which is the East House and the Administration Building. Do not turn onto the gravel road as you do when going to our summer camp facilities.) Park and come in the front door for registration.
- Campers will reside in guest rooms with single beds. Linens will be provided for Camp Snowball campers. Campers will share rooms with 2 - 3 other campers and counselors.
- The counselor to camper ratio is 1:1 (On occasion, depending on camper need and volunteer enrollment, some camper/counselor ratios may be greater.)
- A New York State licensed Camp Nurse is on site 24 hours per day for the duration of the program.
- Camp Snowball offers a well-rounded Christian-based program for our special-needs campers with a variety of activities available for all ability levels. Tuition includes nutritious meals, snacks, and recreation (bowling) fees.
